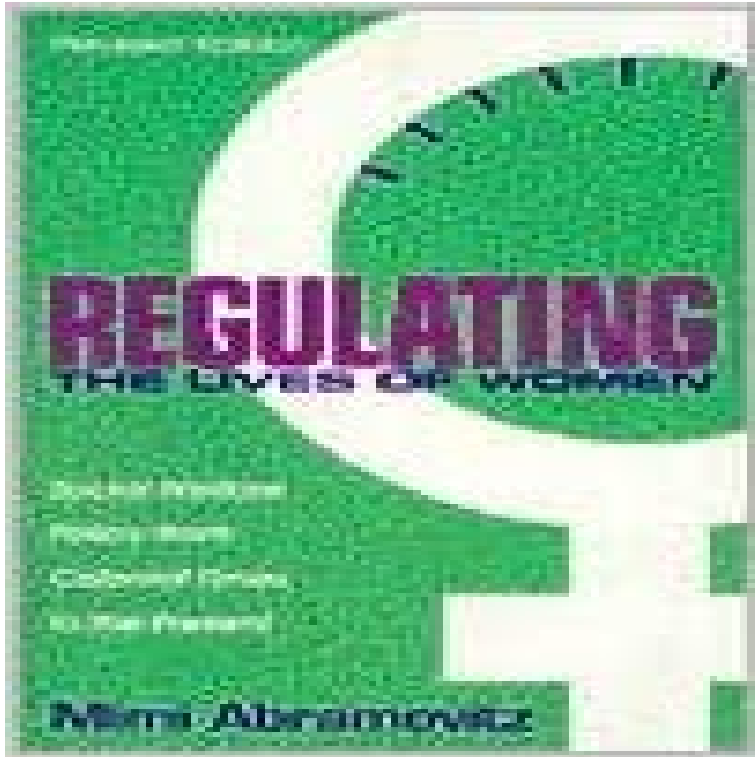


Regulating the Lives of Women: Social Welfare Policy from Colonial Times to the Present
