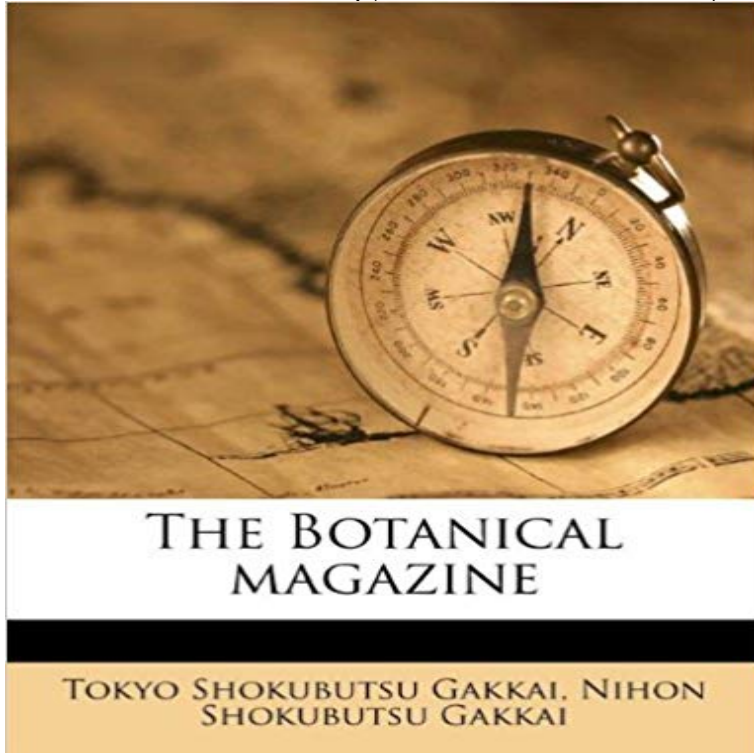


The Botanical magazine Volume 26, 1912 (Japanese Edition)
