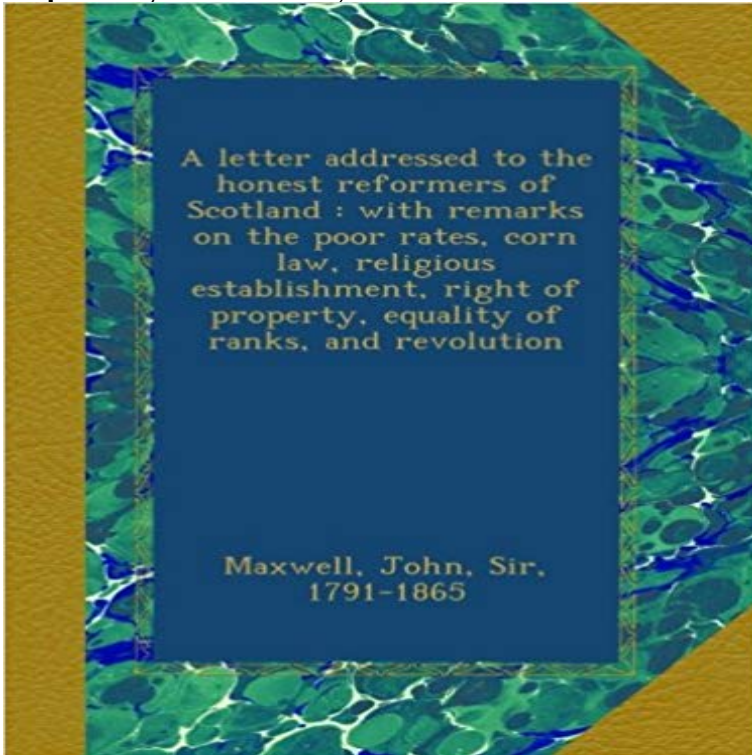


A letter addressed to the honest reformers of Scotland : with remarks on the poor rates, corn law, religious establishment, right of property, equality of ranks, and revolution
