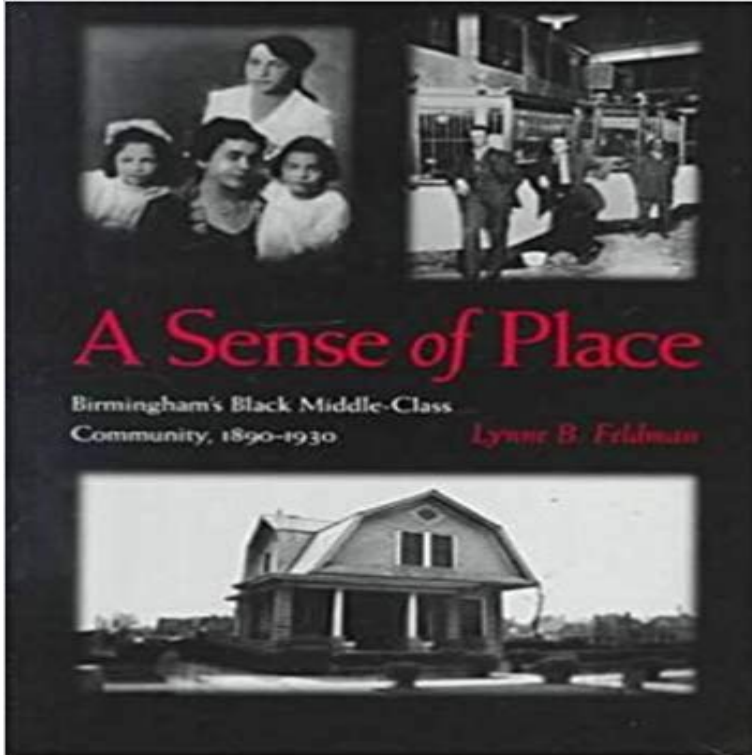


Sense of Place: Birmingham's Black Middle-Class Community, 1890-1930
