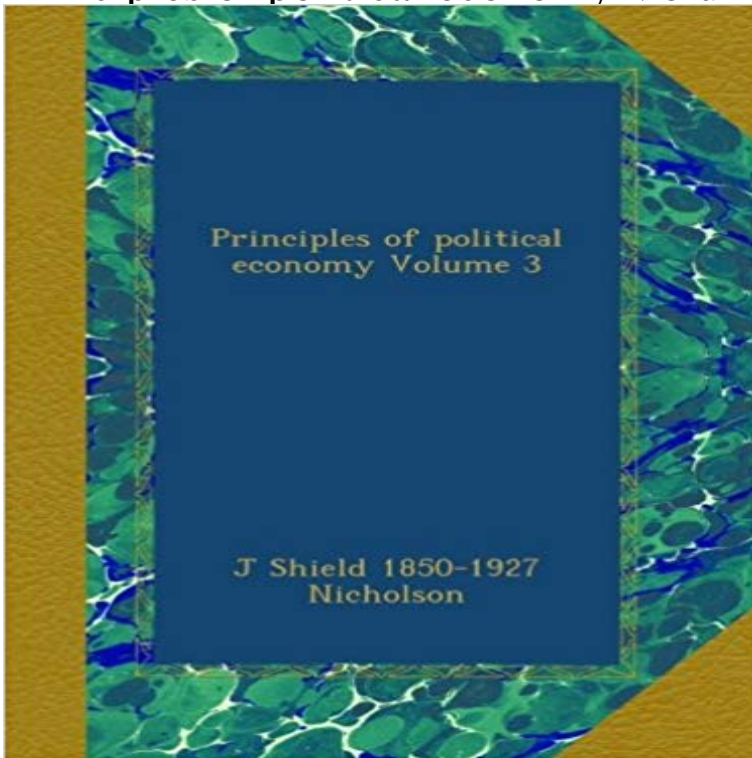


Principles of political economy Volume 3
