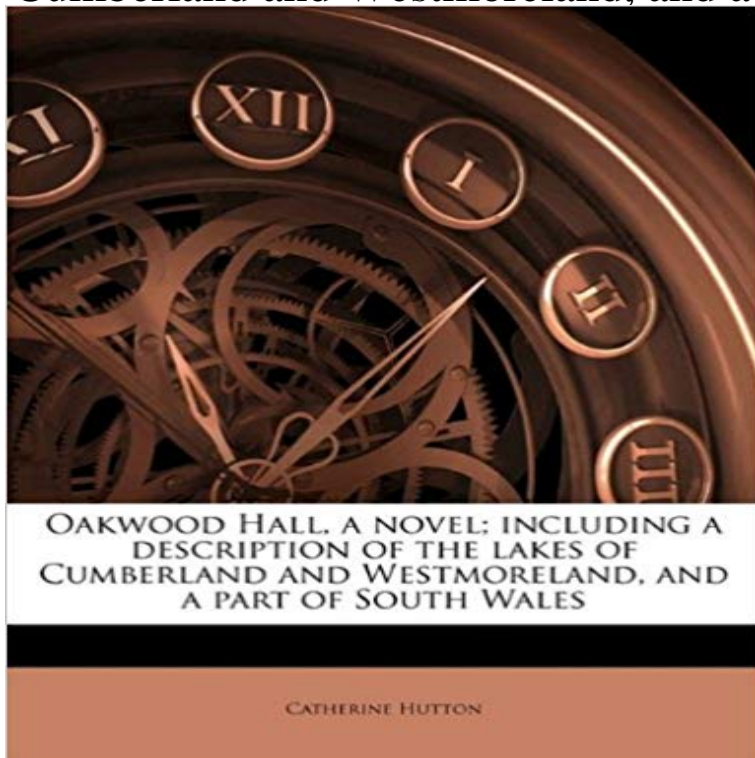


## Oakwood Hall, a novel; including a description of the lakes of Cumberland and Westmoreland, and a part of South Wales
