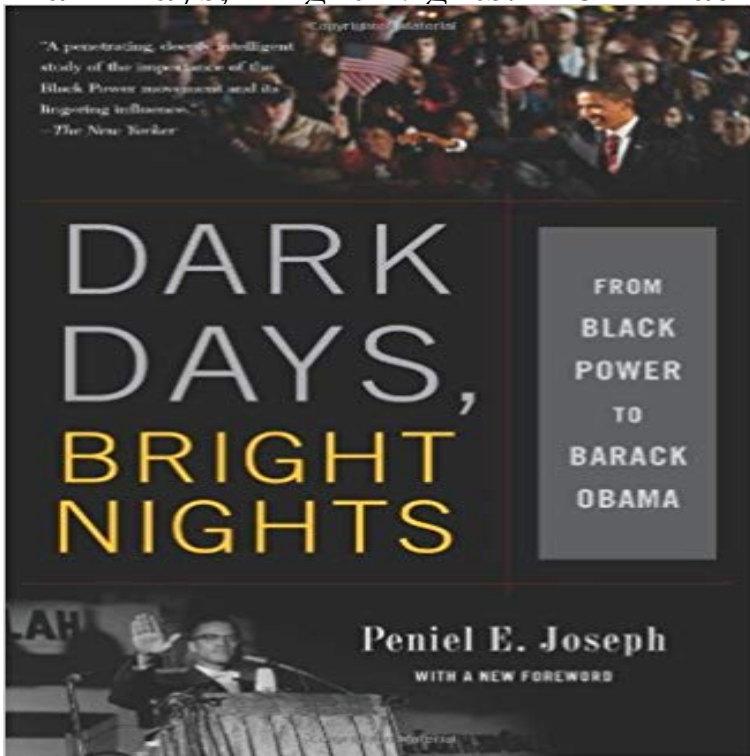


Dark Days, Bright Nights: From Black Power to Barack Obama

This political explosion initially took the form of the Black Power Movement, which, though conventionally adjudged a failure, in fact laid the groundwork for a crucial new wave of black leadership culminating in the inauguration of Barack Obama. In *Dark Days, Bright Nights*, acclaimed scholar Peniel E. Joseph elucidates Black Powers forgotten achievements by retelling the story of the movement through the lives of activists, intellectuals, and artists including Malcolm X, Stokely Carmichael, Amiri Baraka, and Barack Obama. In so doing, Joseph re-assesses a half-century fraught with struggle to expose the Black Power movements resounding triumphs and continuing influence on American democracy.
