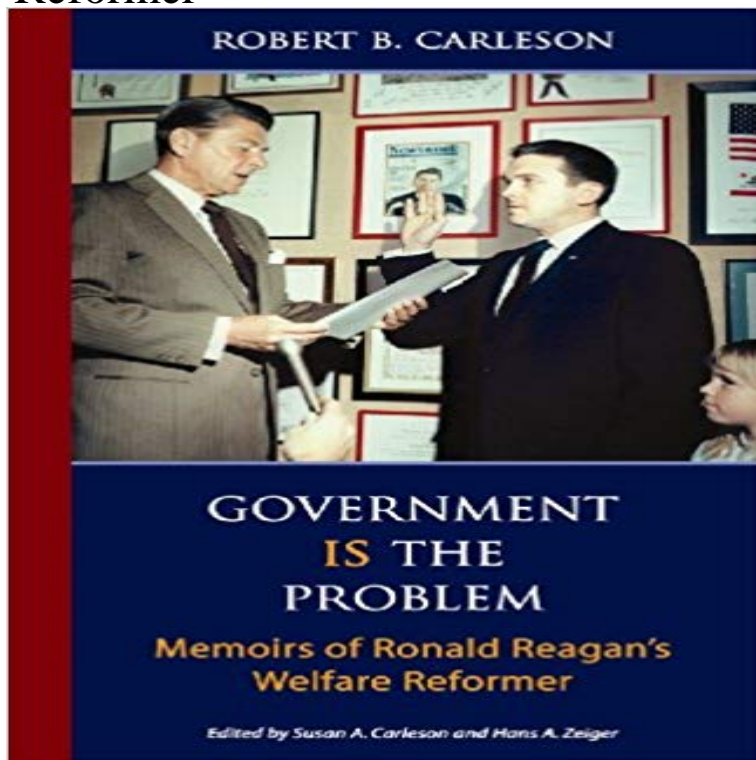


Government Is the Problem: Memoirs of Ronald Reagan's Welfare Reformer

With the country in economic crisis, Americans are asking questions about government intervention in the economy, about individual responsibility, and about the future of our children's freedom.
