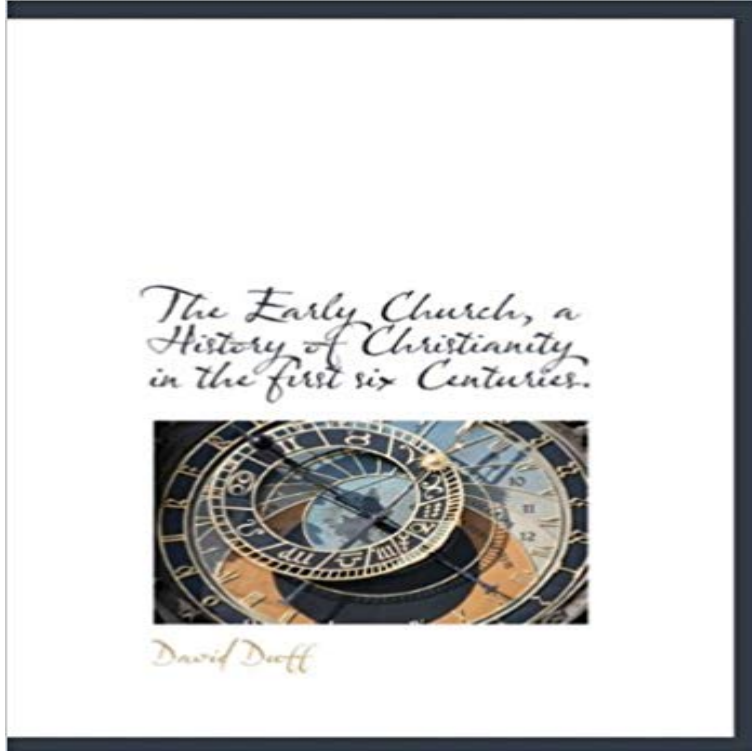


The Early Church, a History of Christianity in the first six Centuries.
