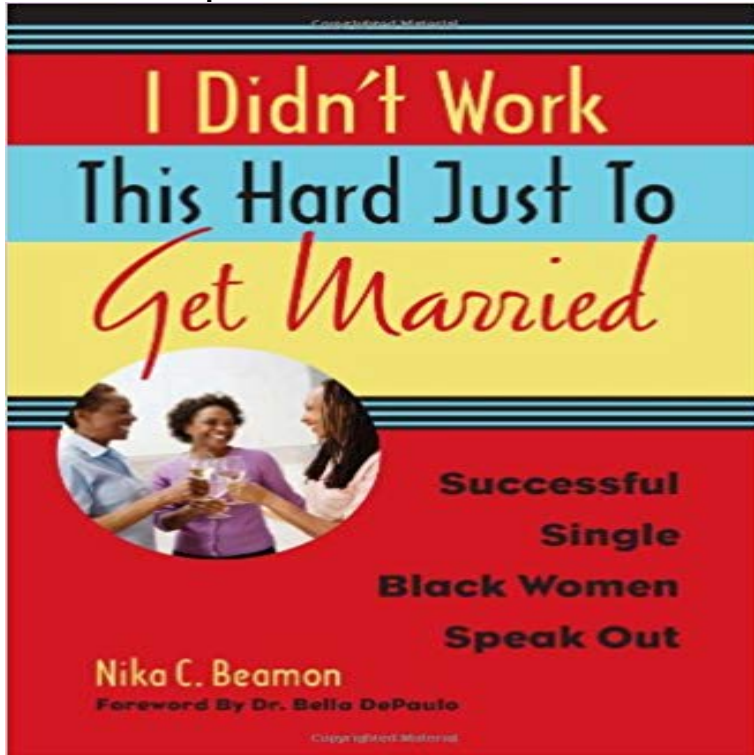


I Didn't Work This Hard Just to Get Married: Successful Single Black Women Speak Out
