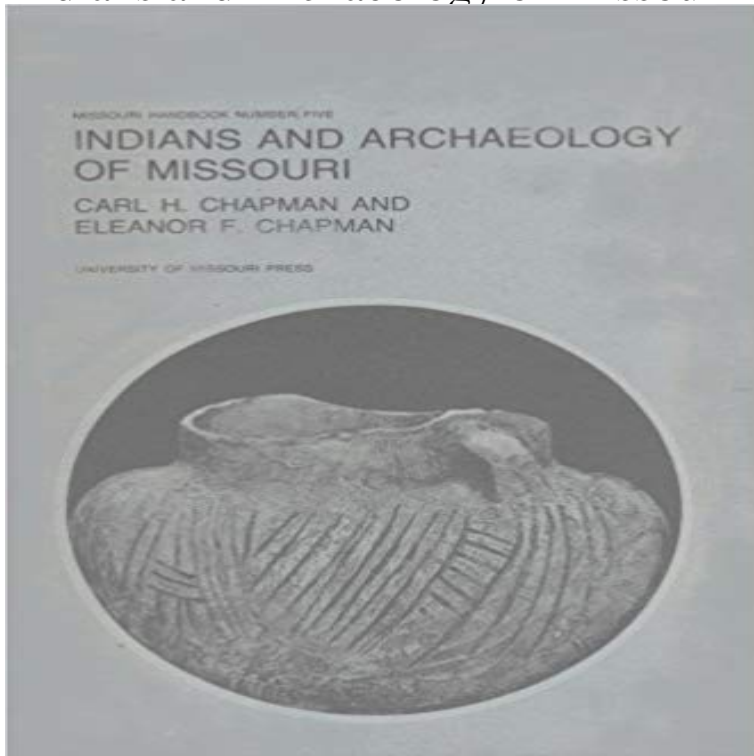


# Indians and Archaeology of Missouri
