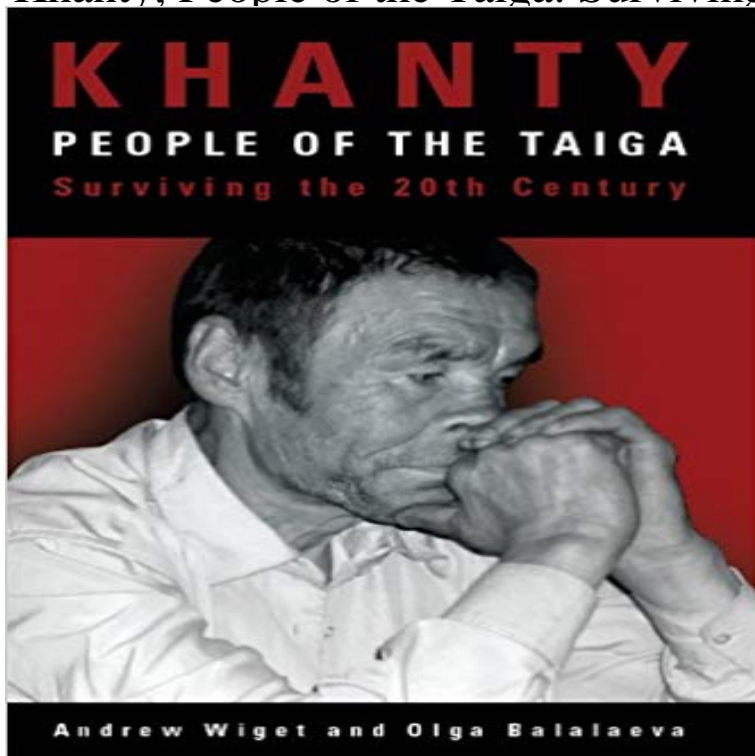


## Khanty, People of the Taiga: Surviving the 20th Century
