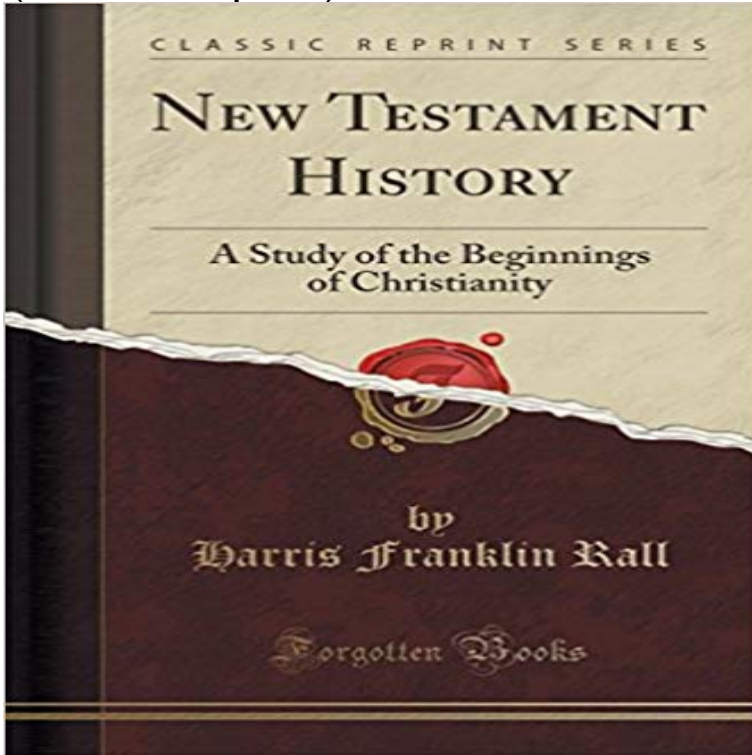

Soares, University of Chicago; and The History, Principles and Methods of Religious Education, by Prof. F. H. Swift, University of Minnesota.
