

The history of the so-called Canmore kings in Scotland, from the reign of Malcolm III (1058–1093) down to that of Alexander III (1249–1286), is marked by an array of insurrections led by discontented dynasts and native warlords with grievances against these kings. Although none of the challenges ultimately proved successful, they nevertheless form a much-neglected theme across a formative era of Scottish history, which they in part define. From well-known events like the invasion of Somerled of Argyll in 1164 to lesser-known challenges like that from Donald MacWilliam in the 1180s, the book offers a systematic exploration of the leaders of insurrection, their aims and motivations, their military capabilities, and the reasons behind their failure as well as the overall impact of insurrection upon the Scottish kingdom.
