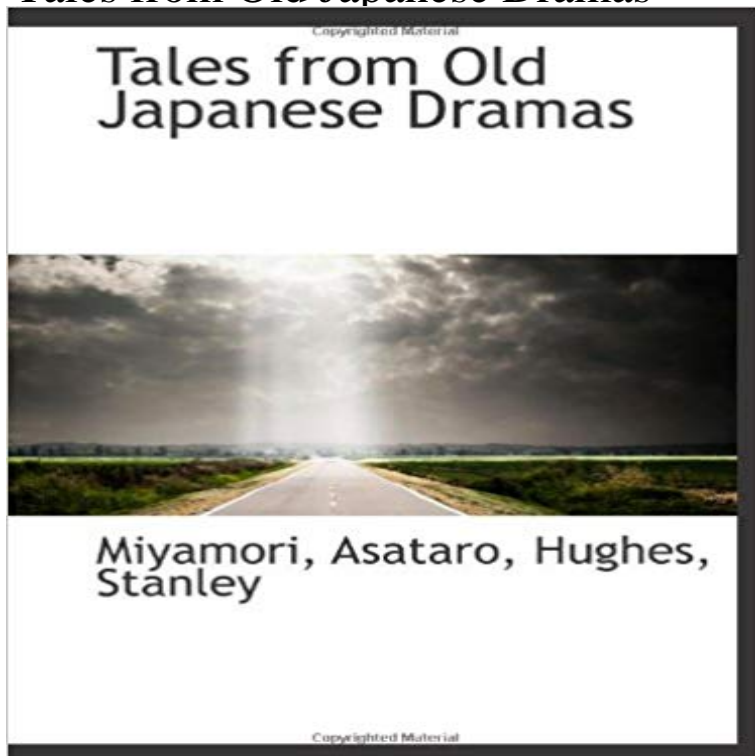


## Tales from Old Japanese Dramas
