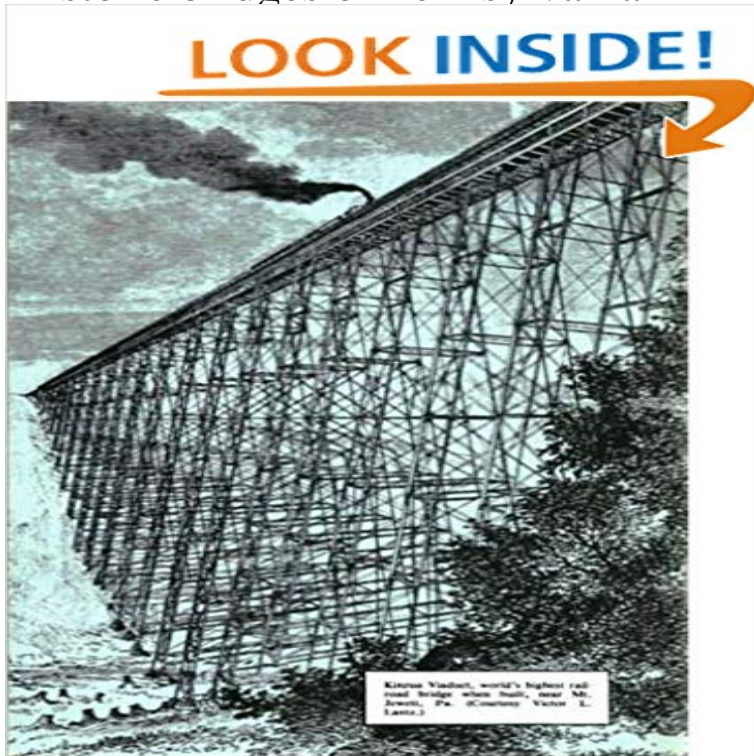


## Historic bridges of Pennsylvania
