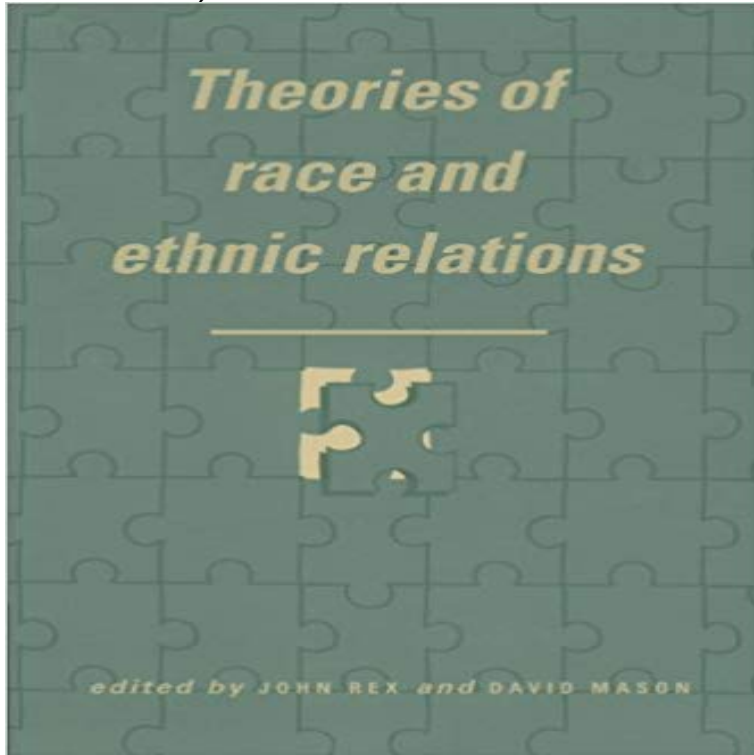


Theories of Race and Ethnic Relations (Comparative Ethnic and Race Relations)
