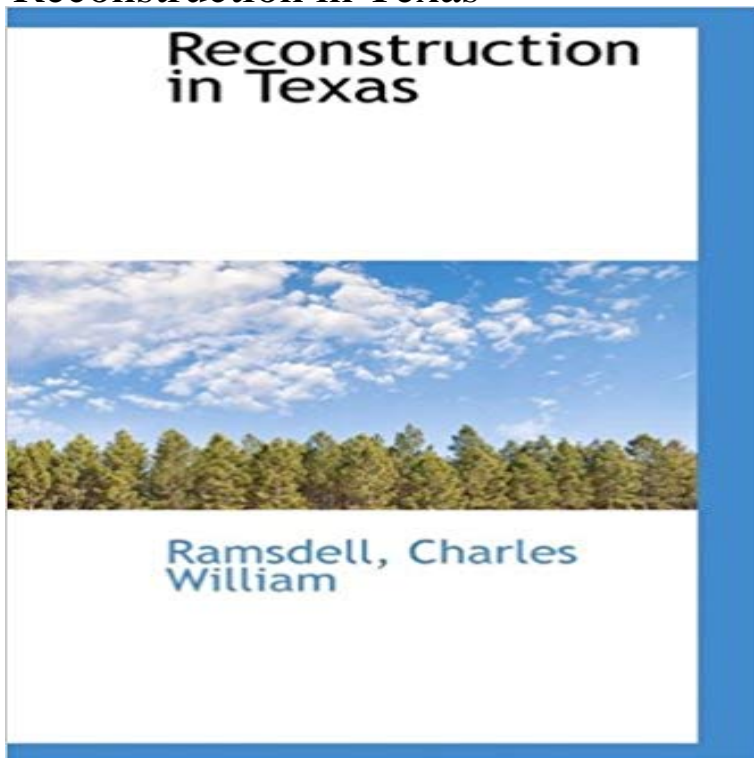


Reconstruction in Texas
