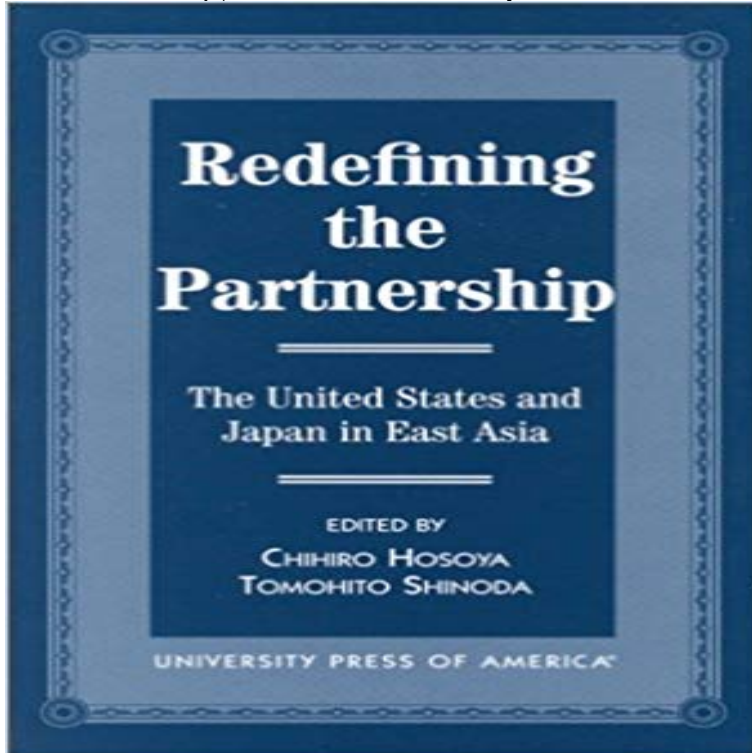


Redefining the Partnership: The United States and Japan in East Asia
