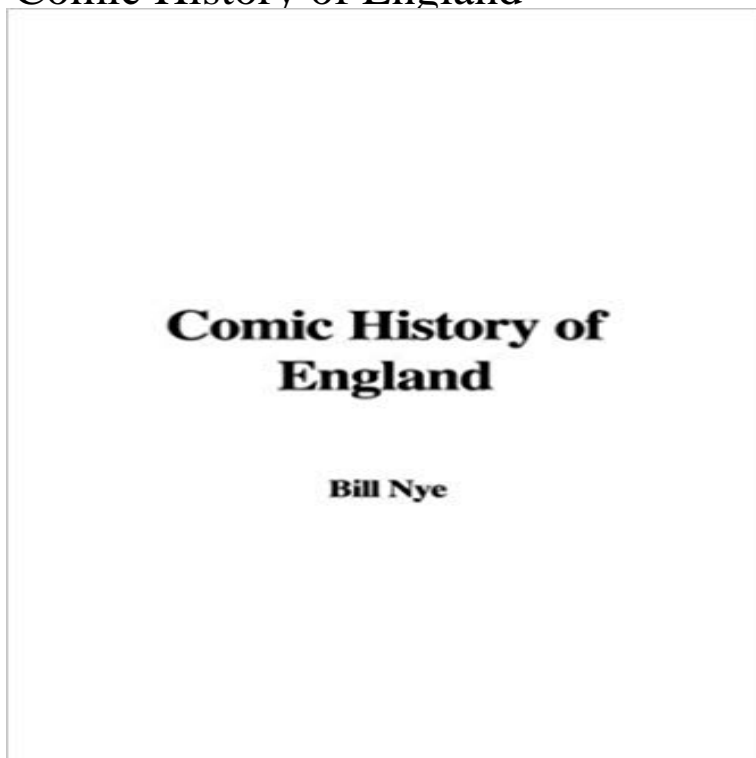


Comic History of England
