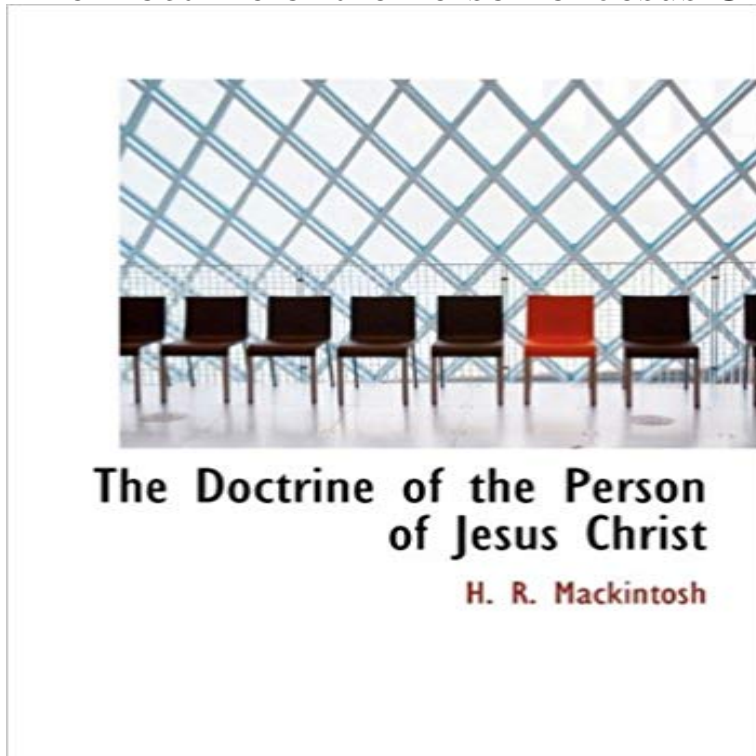


The Doctrine of the Person of Jesus Christ
