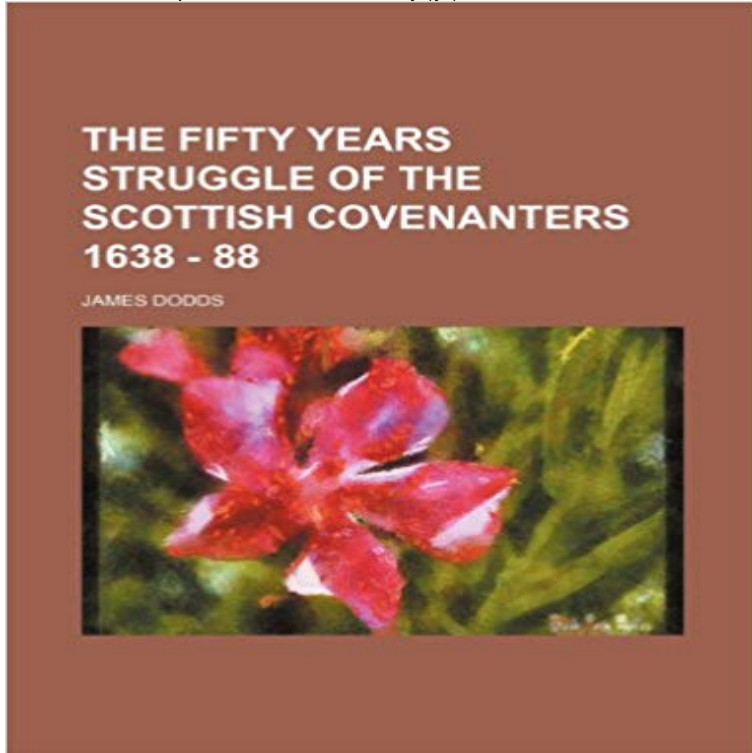

He commenced his operations by affecting to extend toleration to all classes of Nonconformists, and by repealing the tests and penal laws on which the Church of England had reared her supremacy. Besides, the complication of European politics at the moment rendered it necessary to wrest the empire of Britain from the corrupt, cruel, detested hands of
