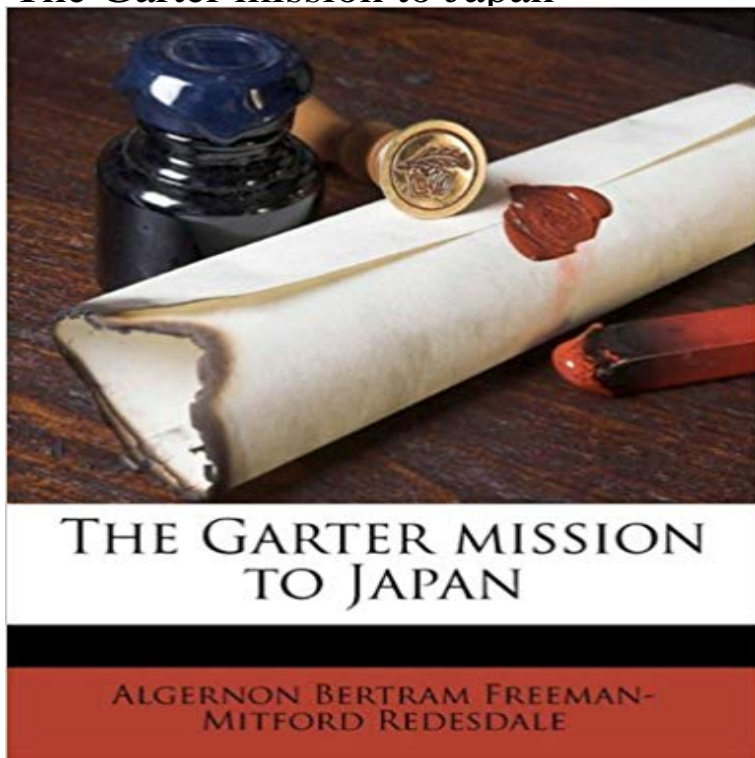


## The Garter mission to Japan
