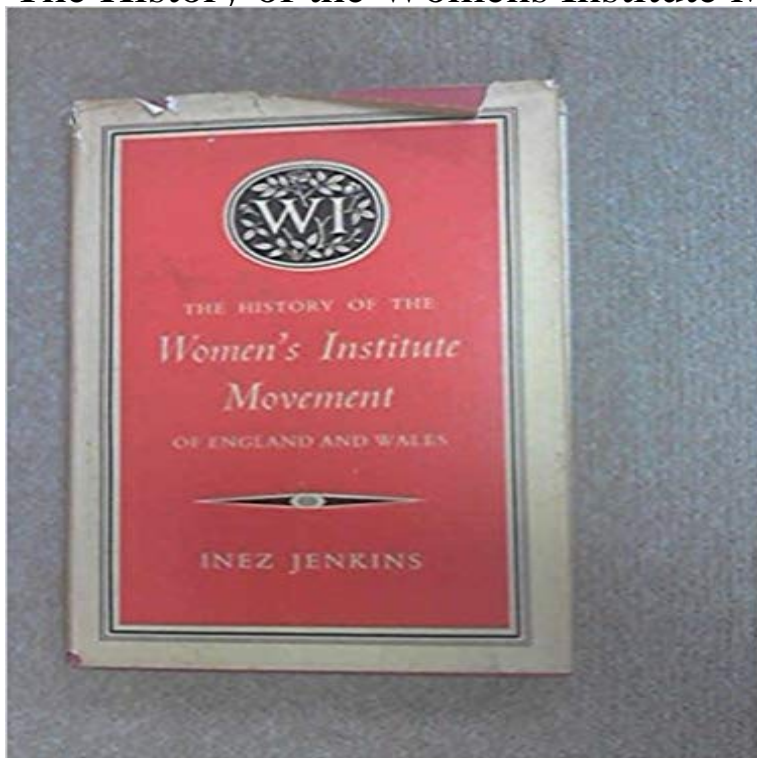

In the final year of the Great War the young Institute Movement brought the spirit of adventure and the stimulus of The Womens Institute movement in Britain started in 1915. AOS Secretary, John Nugent Harris, appointed Canadian Madge Watt to set up WIs across the UK. The first one was at Llanfair PG, on Anglesey, North Wales on September 16th 1915, and the first WI in England was Singleton WI in Sussex .
