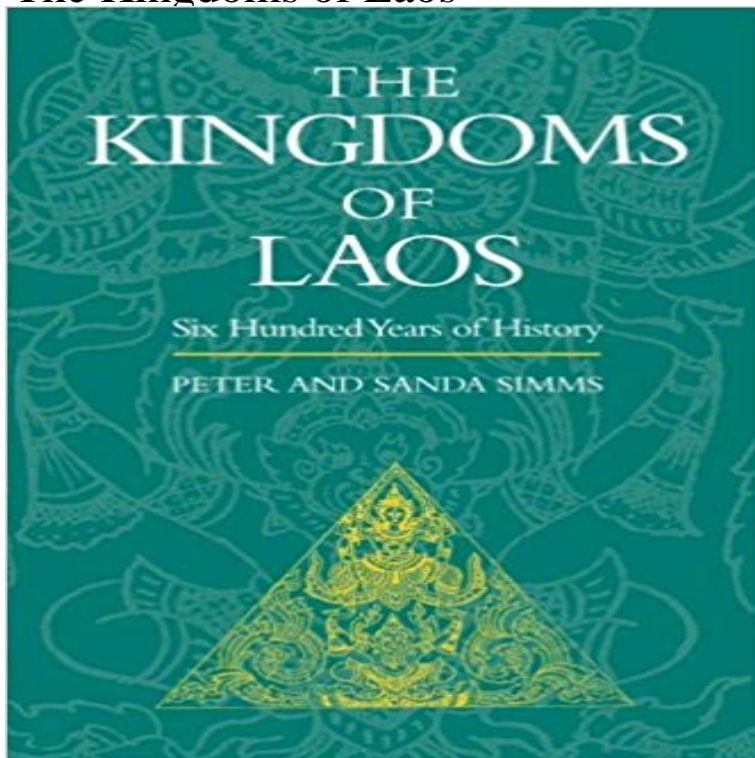


The Kingdoms of Laos
