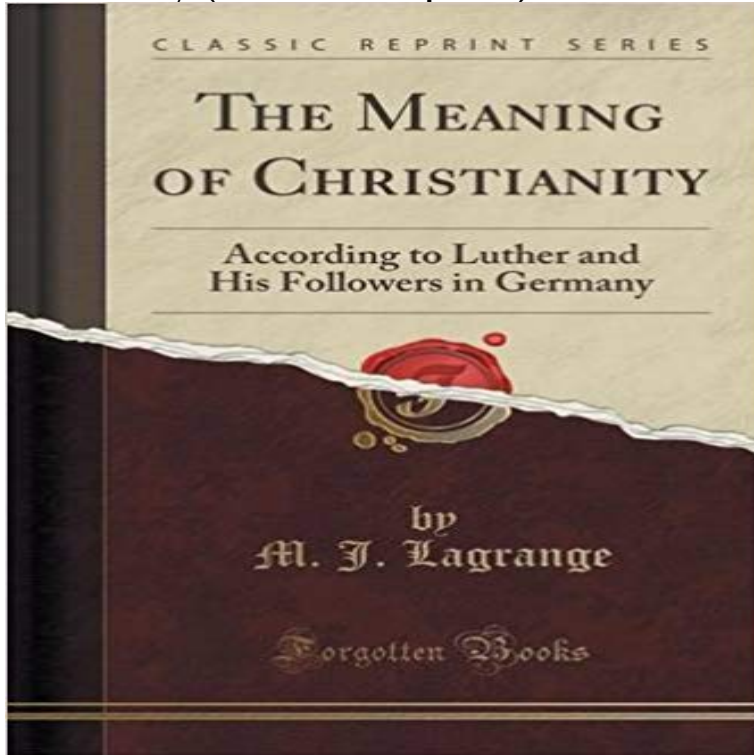


## The Meaning of Christianity: According to Luther and His Followers in Germany (Classic Reprint)

They were delivered in the Catholic Institute of Paris, at the end of 1917 and the beginning of 1918. I had to write them far away from our dear little Jerusalem library; and I was not sufficiently acquainted with the great libraries of Paris to be able to use them with the best advantage. Besides, I have found that these libraries - even the Bibliotheque Nationale - do not furnish complete information concerning the exegetical literature of Germany. This will partly explain the use I have made of the work of Mr. Albert Schweitzer, on the History of Research Relative to the Life of Jesus.
