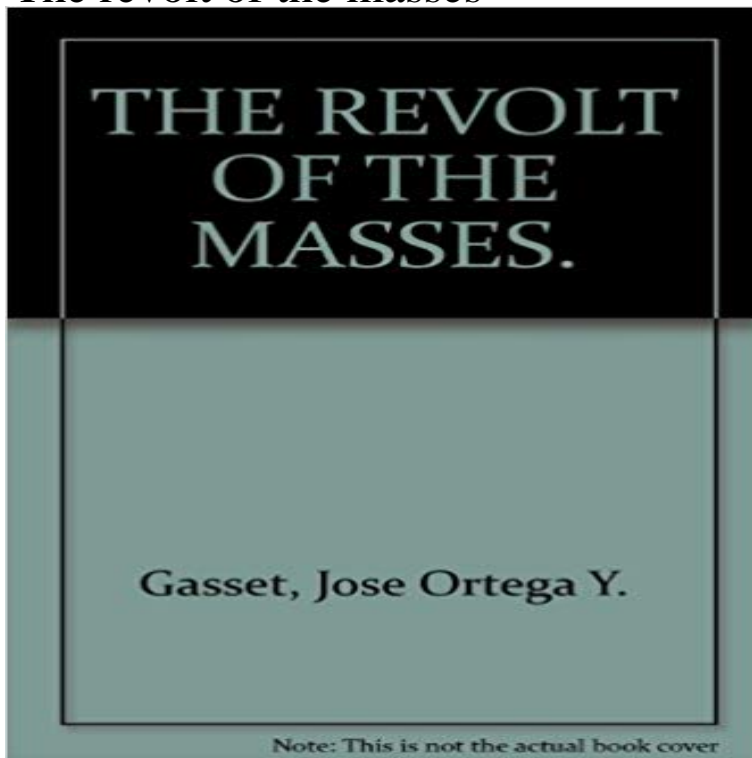


The revolt of the masses
