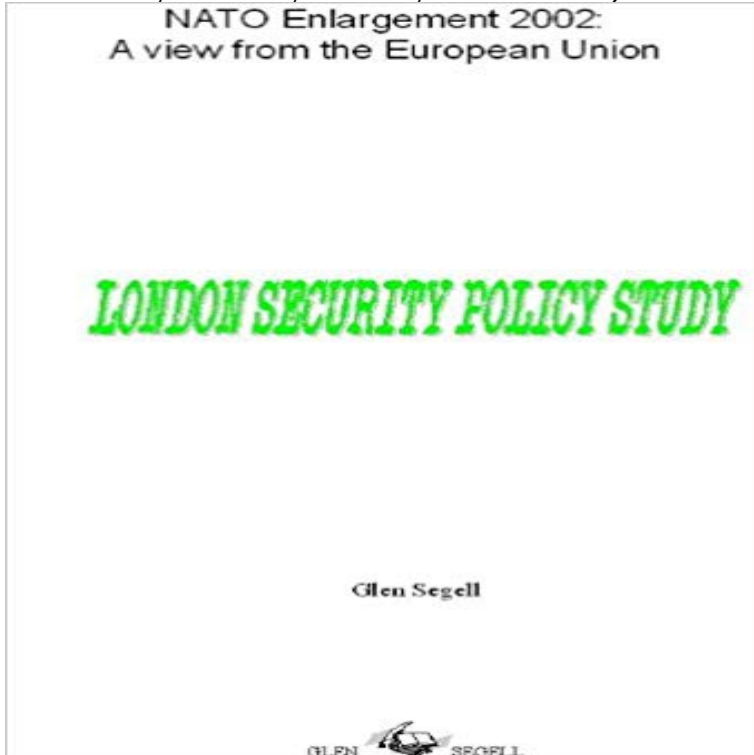


NATO Enlargement 2002: A view from the European Union (London Security Policy Study Book 28)



Europe has three organisations entrusted to care for its security: the European Union (EU), the OSCE and NATO. The EU and NATO intend to debate a process of enlargement in 2002. This article would focus on NATO enlargement from the perspective of the EU. Both the EU and NATO are developing institutions for enhanced European security as part of the enlargement processes. Integral to both debates is the question should NATO continue to exist as the EU assumes a greater role in its own security in an environment where the EU has no immediate external military threat. In answering the question the Dependency School of Core and Periphery is utilised to equate defence and security policy formulation as the Core of domestic institutions within the EU and the Periphery as their implementation through trans-national organisations such as NATO. This school thus links the International Relations of the EU and NATO in generating a common defence, foreign affairs and security policy with the economic, social and cultural Development needed in enlargement to include central and eastern European countries in order to reduce security threats. The Article concludes that eventually and ultimately the EU will assume the role of self-defence once all Europe is in the EU but in the interim NATO needs to enlarge to provide greater security for states and individuals and to further their development.
