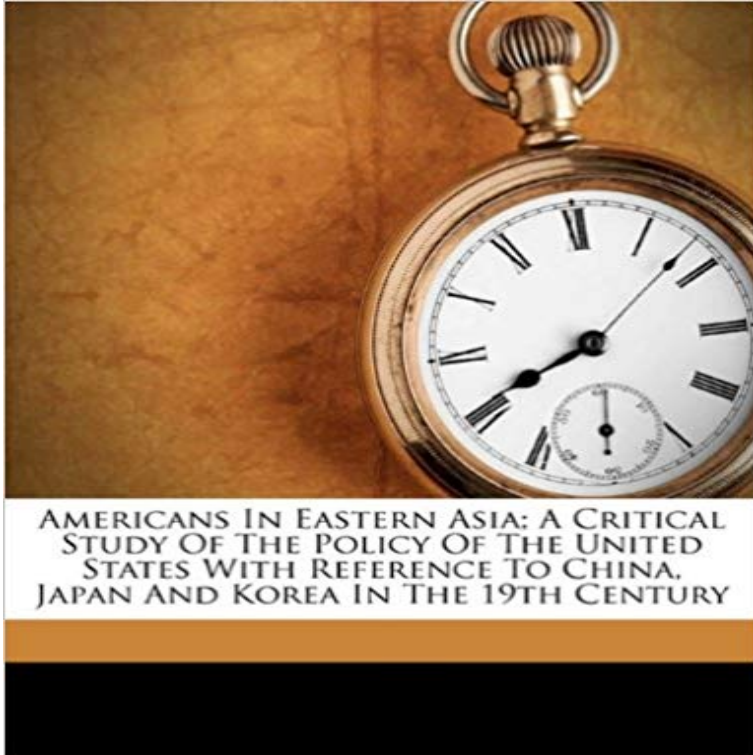


# Americans in eastern Asia; a critical study of the policy of the United States with reference to China, Japan and Korea in the 19th century
